Dear Parade Participant:

Thank you for participating in the 24th Annual Union County Veterans' 4th of July Parade in Lewisburg on Saturday, June 30th, 2018.

The parade will form near the old Lewisburg High School at 9:00am on June 30th and will begin **promptly** at 10:00am. Those who are only participating in the Veterans Recognition Service at the President's Grove (and not the parade) should be at the President's Grove no later than 11:30am.

In addition, please be advised of the following:

1. The parade is a rain or shine event. However, you will be notified by noon on June 29th if the parade is cancelled.
2. A parade formation map is enclosed with your location number highlighted, as well as areas available for parking. Parking will be available at the old Lewisburg High School, Sacred Heart Catholic Church (until 3:00pm), and the Bucknell parking lots. Please fill "Parking 1" first at Bucknell and then "Parking 3." **Buses and trailers should utilize "Parking 2" at Bucknell.**
3. Restrooms and water will be available at the areas marked on the map. Food will also be available for purchase at the Veterans' Recognition Service.
4. **Participants that are contracted to be paid may pick up their check on the side of the old Lewisburg High School from 8:30am to 9:15am, otherwise your check will be mailed.**
5. Please throw candy far enough so that children will not be on the road.
6. **It is imperative that parade participants do not stop or slow down during the parade.**
7. After the parade, there will be a "Transportation Center" at the President's Grove (indicated on the map) available to transport participants back to their vehicles.
